JOB SUMMARY/ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS: Perform a variety of professional and technical duties related to current land use development and/or zoning compliance and enforcement. Review the issuance of building and zoning permits, proposed plats, site plans, rezoning and variance requests among other land use related issues to ensure compliance with all applicable county, state and/or federal regulations. Assist in ensuring compliance and assists with the updating of the County's comprehensive plan and the zoning and subdivision ordinances. Coordinate the scheduling of and ensures that preparations are made for the County's Board of Zoning Appeals, Planning Commission and County Council meetings/hearings. Make recommendations to the County Planning Commission and County Council Committees as necessary. Work closely with the County's Geographic Information Systems, Engineering, Building and Codes, and Permitting Offices/Departments in the development of maps, other documents and processes. Collect data and other statistics regarding planning and zoning issues. Perform other duties as assigned.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Bachelor's Degree and four (4) years related experience required. Master's Degree in City and Regional Planning, Public Administration, or closely related field preferred. American Institute of Certified Planners (ACIP) certification preferred.

Strong personal computer experience including knowledge of Microsoft Office.

Proficiency in ArcGIS preferred.

Must be skilled in the operation of all basic office equipment.

Departmental testing may be administered during interview.

Completed degree(s), beneficial to position, may be partially considered as work experience.

A criminal background check will be completed on selected applicant if a current one (less than 3 years old) is not on file.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS:

This position requires the employee to frequently sit and use hands to handle, or operate objects, tools, or controls; and reach with hands and arms. The employee is required to walk, talk and hear. The employee must occasionally lift and/or move up to fifteen (15) pounds. Specific vision abilities required by this job include close vision and the ability to adjust focus. The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job. HOURS OF WORK/MISCELLANEOUS INFORMATION:

This position is classified as exempt and reports directly to the Planning and Zoning Director. The normal work schedule is (37.5) hours per week. Monday through Friday 9:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. Must be able to attend evening Board of Zoning Appeals, Planning Commission and/or County Council meetings. May be required to work extra hours and to perform extra or different duties during emergency situations. Scheduled hours subject to change.
