JOB SUMMARY/ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS: Under the direction of an engineer, perform technical work related to construction, maintenance and inventory of storm drainage, roads and other infrastructure. Monitor and inspect private development projects for compliance with regulations, standards and approved plans. Assist in project management for the construction of County projects and verifies that proper materials are used and that construction conforms to the contract documents. Assist in the preparation of storm drainage and road system maps, databases and plans. Review applications for utility permits and ensures compliance through inspection of work. Interact with contractors, consultants, developers, utilities, regulatory agency representatives and the general public. Prepare, organize and maintain engineering/construction field and office data, reports and systems. Perform dry and wet weather stormwater outfall screening, testing and monitoring. Perform illicit discharge and illegal dumping inspections, investigations and enforcement. Perform Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) inspections on construction sites and public facilities. Perform post-construction inspections of public and private stormwater facilities and Best Management Practices (BMP's). Assist in collection of the County's stormwater outfall and system inventory as well as making updates to applicable GIS database and layers. Assist in implementing the County's MS4 and Stormwater Management Program. Perform other duties as assigned.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Associates degree in a related field and four (4) years related Engineering experience required.

SCDOT Technician Certification or SCDHEC Erosion Prevention & Sediment Control Inspector certification desired. Candidates who are not certified upon hire will be required to certify within one (1) year of employment, and are required to maintain current certification as a condition of continued employment.

Must have and maintain a valid driver's license for South Carolina with a safe driving record.

Personal computer experience required including Microsoft Word and Excel. GIS experience preferred.

Departmental testing may be administered during interview.

Completed degree(s) not required but beneficial to position may be partially considered as work experience.

A criminal background check will be completed on selected applicant if a current one (less than 3 years old) is not on file.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS:

While performing the duties of this job, the employee is regularly required to reach with hands and arms. The employee frequently is required to stand; walk; and use hands to handle, feel or operate objects, tools, or controls. The employee is occasionally required to sit; climb or balance; stoop, kneel, crouch, or crawl; and talk and hear. The employee must occasionally lift and/or move up to forty (40) pounds. Specific vision abilities required by this job include close vision, distance vision, color vision, peripheral vision, depth perception, and the ability to adjust focus. May be required to work extra hours and to perform extra or different duties during emergency situations.
