Perform shelter exam and evaluation of each animal upon intake. Evaluate animals for any illness or injuries needing immediate treatment. Animal processing and testing. Assist with animal husbandry and medications. Responsible for cleaning and maintaining inventory in dog clinic, cat clinic, laboratory, and euthanasia room. Responsible for isolation ward and isolation animals. Ensure hospitalized patients are receiving care as needed. Coordinate with foster staff/intake staff to schedule appointments for rechecks. Provide quality service to clients, volunteers, and staff recognizing their individual contributions to the success of our organization. Maintain and safely operate equipment used in the performance of duties related to the position. Perform other duties as assigned.

QUALIFICATIONS:

High school graduate or equivalent, and six (6) months related experience.

Must have and maintain a valid driver's license for South Carolina with a safe driving record.

Must be comfortable working with all animals.

Must be self-guided individual requiring minimal supervision.

Must be flexible with schedule changes and short notice overtime requests.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS:

While performing the duties of this job, the employee is regularly required to reach with hands and arms. The employee frequently is required to stand; walk; and use hands to handle, feel or operate objects, tools, or controls. The employee is occasionally required to sit; climb or balance; stoop, kneel, crouch, or crawl; talk and hear. The employee must frequently lift and/or move up to ninety (90) pounds. Specific vision abilities required by this job include close vision, distance vision, color vision, peripheral vision, depth perception and the ability to adjust focus.
